The PTA is excited to present a variety of after school classes for this quarter. These classes are independent of Daniel Bagley Elementary and are managed 100% by the PTA. Please read all of the following information and decide which after school programs would work best for you and your child.

**After school classes begin directly after school and end promptly at 4:30pm.**

If your child is already enrolled in before or after school Spanish, those classes will continue through the rest of the year.

The PTA will try our best to accommodate your child into spring after school classes. If there are more children registered than available slots in a class, the PTA will draw names from a lottery to ensure equal opportunity.

If you wish to register your child for more than one class, please write a **SEPARATE CHECK** for each class (each check made payable to Daniel Bagley PTA). If your child does not get into a requested class, your check for that class will be destroyed.

**\*\*The PTA is committed to offering after school programs to as many students as possible. Please review the registration form for our scholarship and payment plan options. *We will not be able to register your child for an after school class until payment has been received, a scholarship awarded, or a payment plan approved.* Review your options and contact us by the registration deadline regarding financial assistance!**

Important dates to remember:

- ❑ Return all After School Program registration forms and payments to the office or your child's classroom teacher no later than 3:30 p.m. on Thursday, March 25th. Registrations will be processed over spring break and if your form is not turned in by the 25<sup>th</sup>, your child cannot be registered into a class.
- ❑ You will be informed by Thursday, April 8th if your child got into their desired class(es).
- ❑ Spring quarter classes begin the week of April 12th and run through the week ending June 18<sup>th</sup>.

## Daniel Bagley PTA After-School Program Policies and Procedures

The after-school program is presented and managed by the Daniel Bagley PTA. This program is NOT part of the regular school curriculum. Please review the guidelines below:

### For Parents/Guardians:

1. Each class runs from 3:25pm until 4:30pm. Students enrolled in an after-school class must be picked up promptly at **4:30pm**. Parents must come into the building (or Bethany Church if class is held there) to pick up their child from the classroom. No curbside pickups will be allowed. If your child is already enrolled in Boys & Girls Club (and normally attends on the day of his/her after-school class) he or she will be picked up directly from their after school class by a B&G Club representative at 4:30pm and taken to the Boys & Girls Club.
2. **You must pick up your child at 4:30pm.** Because of high enrollment, Boys & Girls Club cannot accept drop-ins of children not already enrolled in Boys & Girls Club. The school office is normally not open at 4:30pm. Doors to the school are locked shortly after 4:30pm daily.
3. If you are repeatedly late in picking up your child, the PTA reserves the right to drop your child from the class.
4. There is no childcare for siblings. All children not enrolled in after-school classes must be picked up at 3:25pm.
5. There are no after-school classes on early dismissal days, when school ends at 1:25pm, or on days when school is cancelled or closed early due to weather. If after-school classes are cancelled due to weather, or other unforeseen circumstances, there are no refunds or make-up classes.
6. There are no tuition refunds for after-school classes. If your child quits or is suspended or dropped from an after-school class, the PTA cannot refund your tuition.
7. In order to make the after school programs run well, we need your support. We may ask a parent/guardian of each student to volunteer to help with at least one class during the session. We understand that for many parents this is not possible, but ask your help if you are able.

### For Student Participants:

1. I understand that rules for the after-school program are the same as the rules during the school day at Daniel Bagley. I agree to follow all school rules during attendance in after-school classes.
2. I understand that in addition to regular school rules, the after-school class that I am in may have special rules unique to that class. I agree to follow any special rules as well.
3. I agree to pay attention to the teacher and parent volunteers during after-school programs, and to follow their instructions.
4. I understand that if I break a regular school rule or a special class rule, the teacher or the parent volunteer will give me a verbal warning. If I receive a second warning on the same day, I may be asked to sit by myself in a time out. If I get a "time out," the teacher will inform my parent/guardian.
5. I understand that if I do not cooperate when given a time out, or if I receive three or more warnings in one day, I will be suspended, and I will not be allowed to attend that class the following week.
6. I understand that if I receive three warnings on a second day of class (or a second suspension), I will be dropped from that class for the rest of the session.

We have read and discussed the Daniel Bagley After-School Program Policies & Procedures and agree to follow the guidelines as written.
