- Artsonia** – Help upload student artwork onto artwork website. Parents can then purchase products made from student artwork as a fundraiser for Bagley.
- Art Walk** – Serve on the committee that coordinates the annual student art show/potluck in May or June. Hang artwork, setup tables for potluck, help recruit volunteers, etc.
- Art Displays** – Assist art teacher by hanging kids' artwork in the hallways and/or local businesses. Hours are flexible and only a few hours per month.
- Book Fair** – Help set up and sell books during the annual book fair to raise funds for the school library. Event takes place after school and during some evening hours.
- Classroom Liaison** – Be the contact for your child's individual classroom when information is needed for PTA functions. Teachers often use this parent as a "room parent" to help communicate with parents and recruit volunteers for the classroom.
- Clip 'n Chat** – Join other parents as we work on teacher projects and assemble the weekly "kid mail." This volunteer opportunity works well for parents who are watching younger siblings. Drop in when you're able - Thursdays, 9:30-11:30am in the 1st portable.
- Event Assistance** – Help with hosting or baking for small events such as the first day Welcome Coffee, Principal's Coffee, breakfast/lunch for teachers during training days, etc. Please specify: \_\_\_\_\_ Coordinate one event \_\_\_\_\_ Bake or Setup/Cleanup
- Family Fun Nights** – Help with planning and/or staffing for 1-2 hours the PTA's Family Fun Nights, including Harvest Hootenanny (Dance), Movie Night, and/or Game Night.
- Finance/Budget** – Assist the Co-Treasurers with budget planning, tracking or auditing.
- Free Money Program** – Assist in this fundraising program, such as by selling gift cards or tallying grocery receipts. Many tasks can be done from home.
- Garden Coordinator for Classroom** – Assist your child's classroom teacher by helping students to prep, plant, water and harvest in our **NEW and BEAUTIFUL** outdoor classroom garden. We will seek at least one volunteer per classroom, and hopefully more. You will be supported by a team of school-wide garden coordinators.

- Giving Campaign/Raffle/Auction** – Help with our largest annual fundraising event. Procure items for raffle, plan party, serve on committee. Year-long opportunities to volunteer as little as a couple hours a month or several hours a week. Event is Feb/March.
- Grounds Maintenance** – Help keep the school's grounds looking clean and fresh all year. Organize and/or attend periodic weeding parties. Opportunities year-round.
- Jogathon** – Help with this important PTA fundraiser. There are many tasks to be done either prior to or during the week of September 26-30th or many volunteer opportunities on the morning of Friday, September 30th (Jogathon day).
- Kindergarten Tours** – Serve as tour guide during the open enrollment period for incoming Kindergarteners. January/February/March, 3-6 hours.
- Library Helpers** – Spend 20-30 minutes on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday checking in and shelving library books.
- Nurse Assistance** – Volunteer for occasional vision/hearing screening and/or head lice screening. Daytime, 3-4 hours. Preference: \_\_\_\_\_ Vision/Hearing \_\_\_\_\_ Lice Screening
- Teacher Appreciation Week** – Assist with this annual spring event honoring our teachers and staff. Deliver flowers, coffee, help set up luncheon. May, 1-3 hours.

- Writing/Editing** – Write occasional articles for Bagley Buzz newsletter and/or assist with other PTA publications. Year-round.
