



What is Free Money and Scrip?

It's an easy way to get extra money into the PTA budget-last year over \$9000. There are many different ways to participate. Parents/Guardians and Children make it happen.

Scrip/Gift Cards: The PTA purchases gifts cards at a bulk discount and when they are sold the PTA nets, on average, 5%. We have a variety of gift cards. The standards have been Fred Meyer/QFC, Safeway, PCC and Starbucks. PCC and Starbucks can be recharged at the store. Last year we also bought some iTunes and Barnes and Noble cards. We're about to get an even wider variety. Scrip/Gift Cards are available anytime throughout the year. An email to the FM/Scrip Coordinator (see below) or the completion of a form (DB front entrance) will make that happen.

Box Tops for Education: You'll find Box Tops on various food packaging; many General Mills cereals, Kleenex Most Box Tops are worth \$.10. The last contest resulted in over \$400 being added to the PTA budget. There's bonus Box Tops too. You'll find all you need to know on their web site: www.boxtops4education.com. We're going to have a contest or two this year, like we have had in years past, but we're changing the way in which we'd like you to submit them. No need to attach them to a sheet of paper. Just add them up and put them in an envelope (recycled is great) and put the total number on the outside. They have to be counted in groups of fifty before they are submitted to the company. Any help parents/guardians/kids can do towards counting in groups make the process much more efficient.

Campbell's Labels for Education: When you save and submit the UBC code from a Campbell Soup Label (and a few other products) they all get submitted to the company. The value of these labels goes into an account for the school and is used to purchase equipment for our Health and Fitness program. More information can be found at www.labelsforeducation.com. While we'll take any label submitted, it's more efficient if you take the time to cut out the UBC code - that's all they want.

Greenwood and Ballard Market: Save grocery receipts from your shopping trips to Ballard and Greenwood Markets. The PTA nets 1% of the pretax total of all receipts added up. Greenwood and Ballard Markets are the only stores that participate. No need to submit receipts from Safeway, Ken's, Central Market We tally all these receipts by bunching them together, aligning them from the bottom and stapling about three inches up from the bottom. It's just the easiest way to tally hundreds and hundreds of receipts. If you want to submit yours this way, thanks in advance.

eSrip: Register your Safeway and Albertsons 'club cards' at these web sites and a percent of all purchases will be donated to Daniel Bagley PTA:

www.escrip.com register your Safeway Club Card number and DB ID #8560884. If you don't know your club card number, just call Safeway Customer Service at (877) 723-3929. At this site you can also register your debit/credit cards, your other favorite grocery stores, and shop with participating merchants.

www.albertsoncp.com register your Albertsons Preferred Savings Card number and DB ID# 49000128521. If you do not know your Preferred Savings Card Number, call (877) 932-7948.

Foil Snack Bar Wrappers: Save and submit your foil lined snack bar wrappers. Any type of snack bar is fine-even the little ones. We "upcycle" these and the PTA nets \$.02 for each wrapper sent in. For more information, and some cool products to purchase, go to www.terracylce.com. Just foil snack bar wrappers please.

Cartridge World: Drop off your used ink cartridges (any kind) at DB. They are brought into Cartridge World on 45th for recycling. The PTA receives a check for the total recycled value. In addition, mention Daniel Bagley at your time of purchase and 5% of your pretax purchase will be added to our cartridge recycling check.

Cell Phones: We collect these too and receive some money for recycling them.

All submissions (labels, receipts, box tops, foil wrappers...) Can be placed in the plastic bins located in the front entrance of the school.
