Daniel Bagley scored a level 5

2nd year of report system - the data is based on last school year (2010-11)

Highlights:

Proud of 5th grade science scores – far above state standard, based on MSP

All of scores are higher than district averages – continue to look at students that need to meet standard

Accountability – level 5 (highest level) – segmentation level right at level four

Need to improve growth long term to maintain level 5 standard

Difference between level 4 and 5 Free and Reduced Lunch gap needs to be less than 25%

More autonomy for schools that score a level 4 and 5
