- Our school will host a full summer school, 16 classes used and begins July 2nd.
- Final class assignments will be sent out Labor Day weekend.

4-Treasurer's Report, Julia Bacharach

- 101 people participated in the budget vote 6/1/10 - 6/4/10 and it was approved.
- The budget changes: increased fundraising and made small cuts on the things that the community questioned.
- Our total projected income for the year is \$108,229, which is 134% of the goal.
- The budget was also approved for the PTA to provide \$4000 toward the Green Fields Project (playground improvement).

5-Green Field Project Update, Kevin Huber

- This project has been going on for over a year now.
- Waiting to hear from the city regarding a \$100,000 grant.
- Currently producing all of the construction documents.
- Would like to have a community meeting for this quarter but waiting to hear about the grant first.
- The 5k run that is scheduled for October as a fundraiser, waiting for the permit at this time.
- Another possible fundraising event is the finish line bricks that people can have their name engraved on for a donation and put into the finished track in the new project.
- Applied for the Lowes Corporate \$25,000 grant.
- Looking for the project to be complete by the beginning of the 2012 school year.

6-Garden Rejuvenation Project Update, Trudy Tessaro

- The 2 wine fundraisers netted us about \$7200.
- Mr. Swann personally donated \$1500 to the garden project.
- Currently at approximately \$10,000.00 in fundraising.
- Have a giving tree in the entry way of the hallway for donations.
- Brass plaque idea was a huge hit at the fundraiser.
- Applying for a grant for \$15,000 (matching grant).
- On Friday the 18th, Windermere will be helping out in the garden from 9am-12 noon.
- Looking to be mostly done by September 2010.

7-Art Walk Debrief, Cindy Potter

- Raised \$480 from the raffle.
- Lisa Newton is going to be the liaison for the instrumental music portion for next year.
- Open to ideas of what worked well and what needs improvement for next year.
